APPLICATION AND DECISION DATES FOR ADMISSION TO 2024/2025 SCHOOL YEAR

The following are the dates applicable for admission to **Junior Infants**

The school will commence accepting applications for admission on	8/1/2024
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	30/1/2024
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	20/2/2024
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	8/3/2024

Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn
